Dear Mr. Cristol:

Pursuant to your request, this office initiated a search of the Central Foreign Policy Records, the principal record system of the Department of State.

This search has been completed, and has resulted in the retrieval of four documents that are responsive to your request. This material has been reviewed by the Department's Division of Classification Review. The results of that review are set forth in the accompanying letter (with enclosures) of Frank M. Machak.

Accordingly, the Case Management Branch has now concluded the processing of your request.

The Freedom of Information Act permits Federal agencies to recover the direct costs of searching for and duplicating records that have been requested for non-commercial use. However, no fee may be charged either for the first two hours of search time or for the first one hundred pages of duplication or, in any event, if the costs of routine collection and processing of the fee are likely to equal or exceed the amount of the fee. Since two or fewer hours of search time have been expended and one hundred or fewer pages have been duplicated, your request has been processed without charge to you.

1. MOB ESTIMATED 500-600 INCLUDING AUB STUDENTS BEGAN DEMONSTRATING IN FRONT EMBASSY 1130 LOCAL. ROCKS THROWN AT WINDOWS AND AT LEBANESE SECURITY FORCES. SECURITY FORCES FIRED IN AIR AND SUCCEEDED IN DIVERTING MOST DEMONSTRATORS FROM FRONT. GROUP SEVERAL HUNDRED CONTINUING DEMONSTRATE BEHIND EMBASSY.

2. AUB CAMPUS ALSO SCENE OF DEMONSTRATIONS MAINLY BY STUDENTS. SOME GASOLINE BOMBS THROWN. POLICE SUMMONED.

3. POLICE AND TROOP REINFORCEMENTS HAVE ARRIVED. SITUATION CONTINUES TENSE. ARMORED CAR AND SECURITY VEHICLES CORDONING OFF STREET. MACHINE GUN FIRE JUST BEING HEARD AND BELIEVED TO HAVE SCATTERED SOME OF CROWD. PORTER
